HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES CERTIFICATE AND INDEMNITY

THIS HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES CERTIFICATE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT DATED NOVEMBER 9, 1994, IS MADE BY ERVIN JAMES THORNTON ALSO KNOWN AS ERVIN J. THORNTON and ELSIE DEANE THORNTON (sometimes referred to below as "Granter" and sometimes as "Indemnitor"), EDM, INC. (sometimes referred to below as "Borrower" and sometimes as "Indemnitor"), and WESTERN BANK (referred to below as "Lender"). For good and valuable consideration and to induce Lender to make a Loan to Borrower, each party executing this Agreement hereby represents and agrees with Lender as follows:

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Agreement. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Agreement. The word "Agreement" means this Hazardous Substances Certificate and Indemnity Agreement, as this Hazardous Substances Certificate and Indemnity Agreement may be modified from time to time, together with all exhibits and schedules attached to this Hazardous Substances Certificate and Indemnity Agreement

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means individually and collectively EDM, INC., its successors and assigns.

Environmental Laws. The words "Environmental Laws" mean any and all state, federal and local statutes, regulations and ordinances relating to the protection of human health or the enviror ment including without limitation the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 5 ection 19601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 6901, et seq., and other applicable state or federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means individually at d collectively ERVEN JAMES THORNTON ALSO KNOWN AS ERVIN J. THORNTON and ELSIE DEANE THORNTON.

Hazardous Substance. The words "Hazardous Substance" are use 1 in their very broadest sense and refer to materials that, because of their quantity, concentration or physical chemical or infectious characteristics, may cause or pose a present or potential hazard to human health or the environment when improperly used, treated stored, disposed of generated, manufactured, transported or otherwise handled. "Hazardous Substances" include without limitation any and all hazardous or oxic substances, materials or waste as defined by or listed under the Environmental Laws. "Hazardous Substances' include without limitatic n petroleum, including crude oil and any fraction thereof and asbestos.

Inclemnitor. The word "Indemnitor" means in lividually and collectively all Borrowers and Grantors executing this Agreement.

Lender. The word "Lender" means WESTERN BANK, its successors and assigns.

Loan. The word "Loan" or "Loans" means and includes without linitation any and all commercial loans and financial accommodations from Lender to Borrower, whether now or hereafter existing, and however evidenced, including without limitation those loans and financial accommodations described herein or described on any exhibit or schedule attached to this Agreement from time to time.

Occupant. The word "Occupant" means individually and collectively vill persons or entities occupying or utilizing the Property, whether as owner, tenunt, operator or other occupant.

Property. The word "Property" means the folk wing described real property, and all improvements thereon located in KLAMATH County, the State of Oregon:

No Notices. Indemnitor has received no summons, citation, directive, letter or other communication, written or oral, from any agency or department of any county or state or the U.S. Government cond ming any intentional or unintentional action or omission on, under, or about the Property which has resulted in the releasting, spilling, leaking, pun ping, pouring, emitting, emptying or dumping of Hazardous Substances into any waters or onto any lands or where damage may have resulted to the lands, waters, fish, shellfish, wildlife, biota, air or other natural resources.

AFFIRMATIVE COVENANTS. Subject to disc osures made and accepted by Lender in writing, Indemnitor hereby covenants with Lender as follows:

Use Of Property. Indemnitor will not use and does not intend to use the Property to generate, manufacture, refine, transport, treat, store, handle or dispose of any Hazardous Substances

Compliance with Environmental Laws. Indemnitor shall cause the Property and the operations conducted thereon to comply with all Environmental Laws and orders of any governmental authorities having jurisdiction under any Environmental Laws and shall obtain, keep in effect and comply with all governmental permits and authorizations required by Environmental Laws with respect to such Property or operations, indemnitor shall furnish Lender with copies of all such permits and authorizations and any amendments or renewals thereof and shall notify Lender of any expiration or revocation of such permits or authorizations.

Preventive, Investigatory and Remedial Action. Indemnitor shall exercise extreme care in handling Hazardous Substances if Indemnitor uses or encounters any. Indemnitor, at Indemnitor's expense, shall a ndertake any and all preventive, investigatory or remedial action (including emergency response, removal, containment and other remedial action) (a) required by any applicable Environmental Laws or orders by any governmental authority having jurisdiction under Environmental Laws or (b) necessary to prevent or minimize property damage (including damage to Occupant's own property), personal injury or damage to the environment, or the threat of any such damage or injury, by releases of or exposure to Hazardous Substances in connect on with the Property or operations of any Occupant on the Property. In the event Indemnitor fails to perform any of Indemnitor's obligations uncer this section of the Agreement, Lender may (but shall not be required to) perform such obligations at Indemnitor's expense. All such costs and expenses incurred by Lender under this section and otherwise under this Agreement shall be reimbursed by Indemnitor to Lender upon den and with interest at the Loan default rate, or in the absence of a default rate, at the Loan interest rate. Lender and Indemnitor intend that Ler der shall have full recourse to Indemnitor for any sum at any time due to Lender under this Agreement. - (c) Any order, notice of violation, fine or penalty or other similar action by any governmental authority relating to Hazardous Substances or Environmental Laws and the Property or the operations conducted on the Property.
- (d) Any judicial or administrative investigation or proceeding relating to Hazardous Substances or Environmental Laws and to the Property or the operations conducted on the Property.
- (e) Any matters relating to Hazardous Substances or Environmental Laws that would give a reasonably prudent Lender cause to be concerned that the value of Lender's security interest in the Property may be reduced or threatened or that may impair, or threaten to impair, Indemnitor's ability to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement when such performance is due.

Access to Records. Indemnitor shall de Iver to Lender, at Lender's request, copies of any and all documents in Indemnitor's possession or to which it has access relating to Hazardous Substances or Environmental Laws and the Property and the operations conducted on the Property, including without limitation results of labor atory analyses, site assessments or studies, environmental audit reports and other consultants' studies and reports.

Inspections. Lender reserves the right to inspect and investigate the Property and operations thereon at any time and from time to time, and Indemnitor shall cooperate fully with Lender in fuch inspection and investigations. If Lender at any time has reason to believe that Indemnitor or any Occupants of the Property are not complying with all applicable Environmental Laws or with the requirements of this Agreement or that a material spill, release or disposal of Hazardous Substances has socurred on or under the Property, Lender may require Indemnitor to furnish Lender at Indemnitor's expense an environmental audit or a site assessment with respect to the matters of concern to Lender. Such audit or assessment shall be performed by a qualified consultant approved by Lender. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Indemnitor or to any other person.

INDEMNITOR'S WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION. Indemnitor hereby indemnifies and holds harmless Lender and Lender's officers, directors, employees and agents, and Lender's successors and assigns and their officers, directors, employees and agents against any and all claims demands, losses, liabilities, costs and expenses (including with out limitation attor reys' fees at trial and on any appeal or petition for review) incurred by such person (a) arising out of or relating to any investigatory or remedial a tion involving the Property, the operations conducted on the Property or any other operations of Indemnitor or any Occupart and required by Environmental Laws or by orders of any governmental authority having jurisdiction under any Environmental Laws, or (b) on account of njury to any person whatsoever or damage to any property arising out of, in connection with, or in any vay relating to (i) the breach of any cover ant contained in this Agreement, (ii) the violation of any Environmental Laws. (iii) the use, treatment, storage, generation, manufacture, transport, relicase spill disposal or oil er handling of Hazardous Substances on the Property, (iv) the contamination of any of the Property by Hazardous Substances by any means what ever (including without limitation any presently existing contamination of the Property), or (v) any costs incurred by Lender purs ant to this Agreement. In addition to this indemnity, Indemnitor hereby releases and waives all present and future claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Indemnitor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any Environmental Laws.

PAYMENT: FULL RECOURSE TO INDEMNITCR. Lender and Indemnitor intend that Lender shall have full recourse to Indemnitor for Indemnitor's obligations hereunder as they become due to Lender under this Agreement. Such liabilities, losses, claims, damages and expenses shall be reimbursable to Lender as Lender's obligations to make payments with respect thereto are incurred, without any requirement of waiting for the ultimate outcome of any litigation, claim or other proceeding, and Indemnitor stall pay such liability, losses, claims, damages and expenses to Lender as so incurred within thirty (30) days after written notice from Lender. Lender a notice shall contain a brief itemization of the amounts incurred to the date of such notice. In addition to any remedy available for failure to pay perk dically such amounts, such amounts shall thereafter bear interest at the Loan default rate, or in the absence of a default rate, at the loan interest rate.

SURVIVAL. The covenants contained in this Agramment shall survive (a) the repayment of the Loan, (b) any foreclosure, whether judicial or

Lender, as holder of any security interest in the Property or the indebtedness secured thereby, or as owner of the Property following foreclosure or the delivery of a deed in lieu of foreclosure.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The followin a miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Agreement:

Applicable Law. This Agreement has been dollivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Oregon. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. Indemnitor rigress to pay upon derrand all of Lender's costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses, incurred in connection with the enforcement of the Agreement. Lender may pay someone else to help enforce this Agreement, and Indemnitor shall pay the costs and expenses of such enforcement. Costs and expenses include Lender's attorneys' fees and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including atterneys' fees and k gal expenses for bankruptcy proceedings (and including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), at peaks, and any anticipa ed post-judgment collection services. Indemnitor also shall pay all court costs and such additional fees as may be directed by the court.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdict on finds any provision of this Agreement to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or sircumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be nodified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Agreement in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not the detained to have waited any rights under this Agreement unless such waiter is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the pirt of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision.
