REQUEST: The applicants are requesting a Conditional Use Permit to allow a 1994 triplewide manufactured home as an additional dwelling on a parcel greater than 10,000 square feet in size in the RS zone. The parcel in question is 2 acres.

AUTHORITY: Article 51.5, Section 51.530(A) of the Klamath County Land Development Code.

PROJECT LOCATION: The site is located on the east side of Patterson Street, approximately 720 feet south of South Sixth Street.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Located in portion of Section 1CA of Township 39, Range 9EWM, Tax Lot 1000.

ACCESS: Patterson Street

UTILITIES:

WATER: City of K-Falls

FIRE DIST: KCFD #1

SEWER: South Suburban Sanitary Dist.

POWER: Pacific Power

CONFORMANCE WITH RELEVANT KLAMATH COUNTY POLICIES:

Notice was sent out to surrounding property owners as well as to agencies of concern. To date, no negative response has been received.

The review criteria of Section 4.030 of the Land Development Code requires that:

- A. The use complies with policies of the Comprehensive Plan.
As the requested use is a conditionally permitted use within the RS zone as adopted as part of the Comprehensive Plan, applicant is in compliance with this criterion.

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- B. The use is in conformance with all other required standards and criteria or this code.

The RS zone allows as a conditional use, an additional dwelling on a lot or parcel greater than 20,000 square feet in size. The applicants meet this requirement in that the appropriate CUP application was made and the lot size is 1/2 acres.

- C. The location, size, design, and operating characteristics of the proposed use will not have a significant adverse impact on the livability, value or appropriate development of abutting properties and the surrounding area.

The parcel is of sufficient size to support an additional dwelling. Access to the home will be via Patterson Street. The proposed home is a 1994 triplewide which meets the standard of manufactured home placement within the UGB and should not create any significant adverse impacts on the livability, value, or appropriate development of abutting properties and the surrounding area. No such testimony has been received from notified parties.

RECOMMENDATION:

Order:

The Planning Director, based on the above findings and conclusions of the staff report and upon review of the exhibits on file for Conditional Use Permit 116-94, hereby approves the request to allow an additional dwelling in the RS zone subject to the following:

1. A placement permit must be obtained within two years of the date set out below or this permit is null and void.
2. In accordance with City code, placement of an additional dwelling will require a separate water meter installation to serve that dwelling.
