The following described real property situate in Klamath County, Oregon:

## Parcel 1:

A strip of land situated in the SINELSEL, Section 27, Township 38 South, Range 111 East of the Willamette Meridian, said strip of land being 25 feet in width abutting upon and adjacent to the Southwesterly right of way line of the O. C. & E. Railroad and being bounded on the West by the Easterly right of way line of a drainage ditch as it is now constructed and as it is described in Volume 246 page 463, Deed records of Klamath County, Oregon.
