Ecposed portion of foundation must be painted or sided if more than 12" above the ground. Exteriors to be finished with natural materials with a rustic appearance.
- (b) All land owners must comply with the laws and regulations of the

State of Oregon, county of Klamath, and any municipality applicable to fire protection, building construction, and public health.

- (c) No commercial, professional, noxious, or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything by done thereon which may become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- (d) The cutting or removal of living trees will only be permitted where necessary for the construction of buildings or thinning for the beautification of the property.
