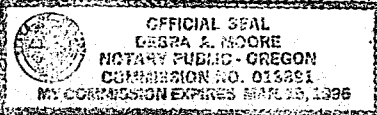

TRUSTEE'S NOTICE OF SALE
Reference is made that certain trust deed made by THOMAS E. DUNAWAY and BETH AMY DUNAWAY, husband and wife, as grantor, to MOUNTAIN TITLE COMPANY OF KLAMATH COUNTY, as trustee, in favor of ROBERT L. HARRIS and FRANCES J. HARRIS, husband and wife with rights of survivorship, as beneficiary, dated September 3, 1991, recorded September 4, 1991, in the Microfilm Records of Klamath County, Oregon, in Vol. M91 at page 17640 covering the following described real property situated in said county and state, to-wit:

By reason of said default the beneficiary has declared all sums owing on the obligation secured by said trust deed immediately due and payable, said sum being the following, to-wit:
