

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Fred D. Bryant and Georgie Bryant, husband and wife, of the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) to them paid by the United States of America, in pursuance of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat., 388), and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, together known as the Reclamation Law, has bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, the following bounded described real property, situate in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon:

All that portion of Lot two (2) of Section eleven (11), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Ten (10) east, Willamette Meridian, included in the tract of land described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Lot two (2) of section eleven (11), Township and Range aforesaid, which is 30.0 feet south and 2038.6 feet West of the section corner common to Sections One (1), Two (2), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Township and Range aforesaid, and running thence South 644.8 feet to the North bank of Lost River; thence west 60.0 feet along the north bank of Lost River; thence North 644.8 feet; thence East 60.0 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described tract of land contains an area of nine tenths (0.9) of an acre, more or less.

And the grantors, on behalf of themselves, their heirs and assigns, will release, acquit and discharge the United States and its assigns, from any and all liability for damages or compensation arising from the entry upon said parcel of land, and from the construction and operation and/or maintenance thereon of works pertaining to the Bureau of Reclamation of the United States, Department of the Interior.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances hereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns forever. And the grantors above named covenant to and with the above named grantee, its successors and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that they will, and their heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and forever defend the above granted premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
