CONCLUSION OF LAW

Respondent is in violation of the LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE 64.060 A2 and B requiring maintenance of an eight (8) foot high fence.

ORDER

Respondent shall repair or construct the fence in compliance with the code within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to comply with this Order The Code Enforcement Officer shall cite the Respondent to appear in Klamath County District Court to show cause why the provisions of the Code

should not be enforced.
