WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Lakeview, Oregon,**

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of April 24, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for" the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the Lot five of Section twenty-seven, the Lot two of Section thirty-four, and the Lots seven and nine of Section thirty-five in Township thirty-nine south of Range eleven and one-half east of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing twenty-nine acres and thirty-seven hundredths of an acre,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in each case made and provided, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT unto the said claimants, and to the heirs of the said claimants, the tract above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said claimants, and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimants, forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
