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CORRECTED ASSIGNMENT OF ADDITIONAL LIENS

Lawvor, as personal representative of the Estate of Luscombe Lawvor, deceased, Klamath County Circuit Case No. 95-01670 CV, ("assignor"), hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto the below-listed persons, ("assignees"), their successors and assigns, and in the portions set out alongside the names of each of those assignees, all of the right, title, interest and claim of the Estate of Luscombe Lawvor, deceased, to recover from Melrose Curran Ryan, aka Melrose Lawvor, aka Melrose L. Curran, deceased, her heirs, successors and assigns, ("lien-debtor(s)"), and from the lien-debtor(s)' undivided interests in real property described as:

"The East 1/2 of Lot 10, Section 3, Township 35, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon,"

the \$271 paid June 19, 1995, and the \$981.31 paid June 26, 1995, both described more particularly in the Claim of Additional Liens recorded at Vol. M95, Pages 24350-24353, Klamath County Lien Docket, plus interest at the statutory rate from the dates of those payments.

The assignees, who have also been lienholders of record and judgment-lien creditors of Melrose Curran Ryan, aka Melrose Lawvor, aka Melrose L. Curran, in their own rights continuously since August 19, 1992, and the portions of the additional liens hereby assigned to them, are:

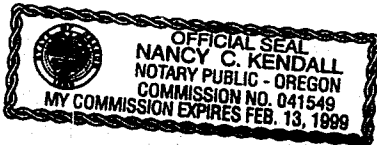
1 Mary M. Lawvor, an undivided one-half interest;
