

RESERVATION: To the extent not heretofore conveyed, excepted or reserved, the Grantor hereby expressly saves, excepts and reserves out of the grant hereby made. unto itself, its successors and assigns, forever, all geothermal steam and heat and all metals, ores and minerals of any nature whatsoever in or upon said land including, but not limited to, coal, lignite, peat, oil and gas, including coal seam gas, together with the right to take out and remove therefrom all such geothermal resources, metals, ores and minerals. Provided that Grantor, its successors and assigns, will not occupy or use the surface of said land and will not do any development, excavation or mining within a vertical depth of 500 feet. Grantor, its successors and assigns, shall, however, have the right to enter upon such land to conduct geophysical and geological surveys and other exploration. Grantee and Grantee's heirs, representatives, successors and assigns, shall be paid just and reasonable compensation for any injury or damage to the surface of said land, to the crops or to the improvements thereon caused by the exercise of any rights herein reserved; provided further, that the exercise of such rights by Grantor, its successors and assigns, shall not be postponed or delayed so long as Grantor is making reasonable efforts to agree upon or have determined such just and reasonable compensation.
