To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting

Executive Order No. 14817

Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Reverend Oregon* whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *William H. McClure* has been approved by law, for the South East quarter of *Section 36* Township *Thirty nine* North Range *Eleven and one half East* of *Meridian* in *Oregon* containing *sixty* acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said *William H. McClure* the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereunto the said *William H. McClure* his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, domestic, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs and in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the appropriate Government to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises here granted, as provided by law, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way for existing or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof, *Grover Cleveland* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be signed by me, the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the *thirtieth* day of *December* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *thirteenth* year of the Independence of the United States.
