
This matter came before Michael L. Brant, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon, on October 6, 1995, in the Klamath County Museum Meeting Room in Klamath Falls, Oregon. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related statutes and ordinances. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Mr. Kim Lundahl and the recording secretary was Ms. Karen Burg. This hearing was scheduled to determine whether Mr. Whittler is residing in a manufactured dwelling without approved Conditional Use, Building and Health permits.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Mr. Whittler failed to appear.

ORDER

Mr. Whittler shall obtain the required permits or remove or cause to be removed the manufactured dwelling by November 1, 1995. In the event Mr. Whittler fails to comply with this order the Code Enforcement Officer shall cite Mr. Whittler to appear in Klamath County Court to show cause why the dwelling unit should not be removed from the property. Bail shall be set at \$1000.00. ted this 6th day of October, 1995.
