This matter came before Michael L. Brant, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon, on October 6, 1995, in the Klamath County Museum Meeting Room in Klamath Falls, Oregon. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related statutes and ordinances. This hearing was scheduled to determine whether Mr. Tolleson is using property in a CT zone as a storage/wrecking facility without an approved Conditional Use permit.
