LOG TRAILER LOADER - Constructed with 18" H-boom, 25 HP gear reducer, cable drum hoist with brake.

veneer TRUCK SCALE - Electric ramp scale made for dual axle weighing.

LOG TRUCK SCALE - HOWE balance beam platform scale.

BOILER - The boiler house is an all steel building with a 40 unit fuel house adjacent to it. The boiler is a wood fired 500 HP KEELER, with water purification system, 12 starter control circuits, turbine fed water pump, I.D. fan, and particulate detector system.

STEAM VATS - Six 12' x 18' x 110' concrete tunnels with cantilever doors and hydraulic controls. The heat system has 3 HARRIS heat exchangers, three 30 HP 1500 gal. sump pumps and condensate return.

FUEL HOUSE - Concrete fuel containment house, 12,000 gal. diesel tank, 500 gal. bulk motor oil, and 500 gal. hydraulic oil tank. Adjacent 18' x 40' maintenance shop.

AIR COMPRESSORS - Compressor room is a separate steel building with panel controls and starting equipment. One 740B QUINCY and one 650H QUINCY, air cooled compressors, both are driven with 150 HP LINCOLN motors.

DEBARKER - Log infeed is twin 3' x 45' live log deck with 12' open center and steel/concrete column base; two 15 HP gear reduction drives with separate controls. Barker infeed conveyor and alligator chain outfeed are powered with a 40 HP DC variable speed drive. 35" SALEM ring debarker with air operated tools and hold down rolls. Control house with console panel and electrical control. Six log clamp hydraulic system, hour glass roll conveyor, 3 sort block bins with hydraulic kickers. Hydraulic operated 84" circular chop saw with 150 HP DC drive.

LOG SPLITTER - 3' X 5' single ram splitter, hydraulic system, 100 HP AC drive. Three deck infeed/outfeed system.

LOG CHIPPER - 84" PRECISION 3 knife chipper; 600 HP AC drive, gravity infeed, bottom discharge; 30" infeed conveyor and 16" veneer trash conveyor equipped with metal detector.

BLOCK INFEED - Two deck system, 30' and 50'; two automatic stop loaders. 10 HP and 7.5 HP gear reducers.
