A strip of land 60 feet wide over and across the following described land:

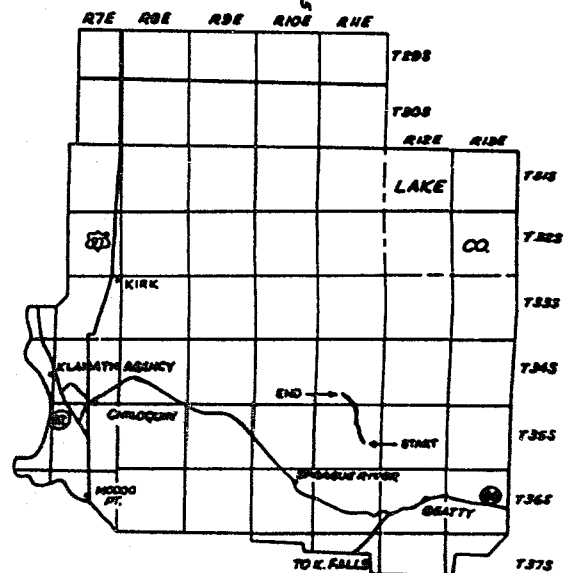
