NOW THEREFORE, the United States of America, by the Forest Supervisor, Fremont National Forest, pursuant to the delegation of authority by the Regional Forester, Pacific Northwest Region, 58 F.R. 30766, published May 27, 1993, does hereby terminate the said easement.

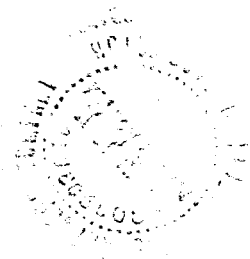

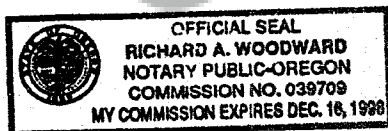
