- All wells shall be securely covered to preven any foreign substance from entering the well. 2.
- All wells shall be equipped vi than access port or airline so that static water level information can be ŝ. determined at any time.
- Well casing must be protected from damage and meet minimum extension requirements. 4.
- Wells may only be permanently abandoned by a licensed and bonded well constructor or a landowner with 5. a valid permit and bond. V/ell abandonment must be carried out in accordance with state rules.
