WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Judgment Decree and Order of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, in and for the County of Klamath, entered on the 23rd day of January, 1990, the hereinafter described real property being:

Beginning at a point in the NE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, which lies North along the section line a distance of 1971.03 feet and West a distance of 430.7 feet from the iron axle with pinion which marks the corner common to Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30 of Township 38 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, and running thence: Continuing West a distance of 139.8 feet; thence North parallel to the Section line a distance of 338.66 feet, more or less, to the Southerly right of way line of the Pelican City Road, 30 feet Southerly at right angles from its center line; thence Southeasterly along the Southerly right of way line of the Pelican City Road to a point which lies on a line parallel to the section line and 284.38

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


