ADDITIONAL APPROACH ALLOWANCE

As part of the above referenced project you will be granted an additional approach to the County's Altamont Drive at Station 118+07 Right. This approach is to be built outside of the project contract.

A bid was received for \$575 from Pave & Seal of 5506 Altamont Drive to build you an additional approach from Altamont Drive. A bid of \$325 was received from Bowers Fencing of 3427 Washburn Way to install a 16' gate. You may have either contractor, or any contractor of your choice, or you may do the work yourself and be reimbursed up to \$900.
