ELSIE JEANNETTE SEWALD, as Administratrix of the Estate of CLIFFORD HAROLD SEWALD (aliases), deceased, having filed his verified FIRST AND FINAL REPORT OF ADMINISTRATRIX AND PETITION FOR ITS SETTLEMENT, APPROVAL OF ATTORNEYS STATUTORY FEES AND COSTS ADVANCED AND FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION ON WAIVER OF ACCOUNTING, and same coming on regularly for Hearing, the Petition having been received in evidence and the Court having considered said Petition;

there being no objections filed thereto, the Court finds:

- 1. Notice: Due Notice of the First and Final Report of Administratrix and Petition for its Settlement has been regularly given for the period and in the manner prescribed by law, with the exception of the California Director of Health Services as decedent was not a recipient of Welfare or Medi-Cal benefits prior to his death:
- 2. Report and Petition: All the alleged acts and transactions of the Petitioner, ELSIE JEANNETTE SEWALD, during the period of the Report are truly shown and should be approved and all allegations of the petition for its settlement are true.
- CLIFFORD HAROLD SEWALD (aliases), died intestate on April 25, 1995, in the County of Butte, State of California, and was a resident of the County of Tehama, State of California, on the date of his death. Petitioner qualified as Special Administrator of this Estate on July 19, 1995, and qualified as General Administrator and Letters of Administration were issued to said Petitioner on August 22, 1995. At all times since the issuance of Letters of Administration, Petitioner has been and now is the duly qualified and acting Administrator of decedent's Estate.
- 4. Notice of Death: Notice of Death and of Petition to administer Estate has been published for the period and in the manner prescribed by law, and Proof of Publication was filed with

the Clerk of this Court on July 28, 1995, showing due publication in the manner and form required by law.

- 5. <u>Creditors' Claims</u>: Reasonable efforts have been made to identify all creditors of the estate, pursuant to California Probate Code §9050. Notice of Administration of Estate was mailed to all known Creditors on August 22, 1995. A Creditor's Claim was filed by Dennis Sewald on December 14, 1995 and was rejected by the Administratrix on December 19, 1995. An Amended Creditor's Claim was filed by Dennis Sewald on February 1, 1996; said Amended Creditor's Claim was rejected by the Administratrix on February 6, 1996 and rejected by the Court on February 14, 1996 pursuant to the Court's Minute Order dated February 14, 1996. No other Creditor's Claims have been presented to the Administratrix or filed with this Court. The time for filing and presenting Creditors' Claims expired on December 22, 1995.
- Appraisement of the Estate was returned and filed on December 13, 1995, showing the value of the probate estate to be One Hundred Sixty-nine Thousand One Hundred Forty-six and 69/100 Dollars (\$169,146.69). A Final Inventory and Appraisement was filed on April 22, 1996 showing additional separate property of decedent of \$4,508.37, which was integrated with Inventory and Appraisement, Partial No. 1, for a total value of \$173,655.06. A Corrected Complete and Final Inventory and Appraisement was filed in this

Estate on July 17, 1996 showing a total corrected value of decedent's community property interest to be \$145,915.48 and separate property to be \$50,855.79, with the total estate assets valued as \$196,771.28.

Petitioner alleges that the corrected Inventory and Appraisement totaling One Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-one and 28/100 Dollars (\$196,771.28), contains all of decedent's interest in community and separate property.

- 7. <u>Personal Property Taxes</u>: All personal property taxes due and payable by the estate have been paid or provided for.
