10.2 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent shall not constitute a consent to other transfers or a waiver of this section. No transfer by Grantor shall relieve Grantor of liability for payment of the Indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Agreement or waive any right or remedy under this Deed of Trust or the Agreement without relieving Grantor from liability. Grantor waives notice, presentment, and protest with respect to the Indebtedness.

11.1 Security Agreement; Financing Statements.

11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the eitent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is facted.

11.2 Security Interest. 13. Possible Actions of Credit Union.

 (5) The maximum annual percentage rate under the Agreement is reached.
 (6) Any government action prevents Credit Union from imposing the annual percentage rate provided for or impairs Credit Union's security interest such that the value of the cent of the credit line

(7) Credit Union has been notified by government agency that continued advances would constitute an unsafe and unsound practice.

Change in Terms. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make certain change sto the terms of the Agreement at specified times or upon the occurrence of specified events.

Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect (b) With respect to all or any part of in the state in which the Credit Union is located.

(c) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Credit Union. If the Income is collected by Credit Union, then Grantor irrevocably designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

(d) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Credit Union's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Credit Union shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

(e) If Grantor shall become a tenant at will of Credit Union or the property after the Property and shall pay while in possession a reasonable rental for use of the Property.

(f) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Cred t Union or its designee may vote on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners, pursuant to the power of attorney granted Credit Union in Section 16.2.

Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note. (a)

14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, or to sell certain portions of the Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any portion of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Sale. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale on all or any portion of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.

14.4 Walver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a treach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Credit Union's right to take actions on the indebtedness and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

14.5 Attomeys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attomeys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a lawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgment collection actions.

15. Notice

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if malled, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. Credit Union requests that copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Credit Union's address, as set forth on page one of this Deed of Trust. If the Property is in California, the notice shall be as provide by Section 2924b of the Civil Code of California. If this property is in Virginia, the following notice applies: NOTICE — THE DEBT SECURED HEREBY IS SUBJECT TO CALL IN FULL OR THE TERMS THEREOF MODIFIED IN THE EVENT OF SALE OR CONVEYANCE OF THE PROPERTY CONVEYED.

15. Miscellaneous.

16.1 Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Grantor's interest, and subject to the provisions of applicable law with respect to successor trustees, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns.

16.2 Unit Ownership Power of Attorney. If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Grantor grants an irrevocable power of attorney to Credit Union to vote in its discretion on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners. Credit Union shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after default by Grantor and may decline to exercise this power, as Credit Union may see fit.

16.3 Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than grantor's residence, within 60 days following the close of each fiscal year of Grantor, Grantor shall furnish to Credit Union a statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such detail as Credit Union shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

16.4 Applicable Law. The law of the state in which the Property is located shall be applicable for the purpose of construing and determining the validity of this Deed of Trust and, determining the rights and remedies of Credit Union on default. 16.5 Joint and Several Liability. If Grantor consists of more than one person or entity, the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several.

15.6 Time of Essence. Time is of the essence of this Deed of Trust.

16.7 Use.

(a) If located in Idaho, the Property either is not more than twenty acres in area or is located within an incorporated city or village.

If located in Washington, the Property is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes. (b)

If located in Montana, the Property does not exceed fifteen acres and this instrument is a Trust Indenture executed in conformity with the Small Tract Financing Act of Montana. (c)

16.10 Substitute Trustee. Credit Union, at Credit Unions option, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Credit Union and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the county where the Property is located. The instrument shall contain the name of the original Credit Union, Trustee, and Borrower, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee shall, without conveyance of the Property, succeed to all the title, powers, and duties conferred upon the Trustee herein and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

16.11 Statement of Obligation. If the Property is in California, Credit Union may collect a fee not to exceed \$50 for furnishing the statement of obligation as provided by Section 2943

16.12 Severability. If any provision in this Deed of Trust shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.
