# IN THE MATTER OF CUP 110-96 FOR KLAMATH PACIFIC

#### APPLICATION:

The applicant requested approval of a CUP for a mineral extraction site and accessory uses on 130 acres zoned NR (Non Resource). A hearing was held by the Planning Commission on JANUARY 28, 1997. This application was reviewed for conformance with Articles 44, 57 and 81 of the Klamath County Land Development Code.

## LOCATION:

Balsam Dr., west of the intersection with Long Lake Rd., west of Stewart-Lenox. Portions S 1/2 Sec. 11, T 39S R 8E., T.A. 3908-000-2100.

### **RELEVANT FACTS:**

The application is for a CUP to allow mineral extraction activities on 130 acres. The plan/zone designation for the project site is NR/Non Resource. The property is adjacent to an existing site operated by the applicant.

# **CONCLUSIONS AND ORDER:**

The Klamath County Planning Commission, based on testimony entered and upon consideration of exhibits a-d find the application in conformance with the review criteria set out in the Code.

Therefore, it is ordered the application of KLAMATH PACIFIC for approval of CUP 110-96 is granted conditioned upon compliance with Articles 57 and 81, and subject to DOGAMI permitting procedures.
