ORDER 97-138

According to the provisions of ORS 368.351, a petition containing the acknowledged signatures of the owners of 100% of the property abutting the public property described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, proposed to be vacated and indicating said owners approval of the proposed vacation was filed with the Board of Commissioners on February 28th, 1997.

Thereafter, the Public Works Director filed with the Commissioners a written report containing the required information of ORS 368.346(1), finding the vacation to be in the public interest.

Now, after fully considering the report and other documentation presented, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the vacation of Lots 13 & 14, Ankeny Garden Tracts, as described on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is in the public interest and finds that the petition should be granted and that the real property should be vacated.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition is granted and that the portion described herein is vacated, as said vacation in the public interest. It is further ordered that pursuant to ORS 365.366(1)(d) the vacated property is vested in the owners of the abutting property by extension of their property boundaries.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs resulting from the approved vacation is determined to be in the sum of \$100.00 and that the persons liable for payment of the costs are the petitioners, who have paid the above mentioned sum on February 26, 1997.
