a. Termination and Acceleration. The Credit Union may terminate your Agreement and require Grantor to pay the emire outstanding balance immediately, and charge Grantor certain fees if any of the following happen:

(1) Grantor engages in any fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with the Agreement. For example, if there are false statements or omissions on Grantor's application or financial statements.

(2) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the Agreement.

(3) Grantor's actions or inactions adversely affect the collateral or Credit Union's rights in the collateral. For example, if Grantor falls to: maintain insurance, pay taxes; iterative by Suspension of Credit/Reduction of Credit Limit. Credit Union may refuse to make additional advances on the line of credit or reduce the credit Emit during any period in which the following exist or occur:

b. Suspension or predictions of the discourse of the following exist or occur:

(1) Any of the circumstance: "sted in all, above.

(2) The value of Granton's dwelling securing the Indebtedness declines significantly below its appraised value for purposes of the Agreement.

(3) Credit Union reasonably believes that Granton will not be able to meet the repayment requirements of the Agreement due to a material change in Granton's financial discourse of the Agreement and Deed of Trust.

(4) Grantor(s) are in default under any material obligation of the Agreement and Deed of Trust.
(5) The maximum annual percentage rate under the Agreement is reached.
(6) Any government action prevents Credit Union from imposing the annual percentage rate provided for or impairs Credit Union's security interest such that the value of the interest is less than 120 percent of the credit line.
(7) Credit Union has been notified by government agency that continued advances would constitute an unsafe and unsound practice.

Chapter in Terror. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make cartely chapters the learns of the Agreement agency that continued advances would constitute an unsafe and unsound practice.

Change in Terms. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make certain changes to the terms of the Agreement at specified times or upon the occurrence of specified events. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

(b) With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect in the state in which the Credit Union is located.

(c) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Granter, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use payment thereof in the name of Granter and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand chall the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

person, by agent, or through a receiver.

(d) Credit Union shell have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property precading foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver shall exist whether or not the appointment of a receiver substantial amount. Employment by Credit Union's right to the appointment of a receiver shall amount. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before this time of the sale or disposition.

14.4 Walver, Election of Remedies. A valver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

14.5 Attorneys' Epoc Expenses it Credit Union in particles and an election to make and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

14.5 Altomays' Fees: Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement.
