

CERTIFICATE FOR SERVANT IN CONGREGATION

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that RICHARD GEORGE PERRY is a duly ordained minister of Jehovah's Witnesses, engaged in preaching and teaching the principles of this Society and administering the rites and ceremonies thereof in public worship.

He has been duly ordained in accordance with the principles prescribed by this Society. This was by a public ceremonial on January 14, 1951, whereby he confessed in the presence of witnesses that his life was thereafter dedicated to the service of Almighty God, Jehovah, as a minister and to follow the footsteps of Christ Jesus, preaching God's Kingdom of righteousness. Since such date he has been recognized by this Society as qualified to represent it in such capacity.

He presently officiates as ~~an assistant~~ presiding minister of the Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses. He has been serving since August 21, 1959 as the Congregation Servant and Watchtower Study Conductor for this congregation and as such he has general supervision of the activities of Jehovah's Witnesses in that area in preaching the doctrines and principles of Jehovah's Witnesses, which include Bible studies in the homes of the people and all services at the local headquarters.

He also regularly and customarily engages in preaching and teaching the tenets and principles of Jehovah's Witnesses as a missionary evangelist. He is authorized to perform the ordinary rites and ceremonies recognized and employed by Jehovah's Witnesses. And he performs such other ministerial duties as are required of him as ~~an assistant~~ presiding minister.

He is therefore declared and certified by this Society to be, in accordance with its principles, a duly ordained minister, having the qualifications to preach the Gospel of God's Kingdom through Christ Jesus.—Isaiah 61:1, 2; Matthew 24:14.
