I, David Van De Kop, being first duly sworn, say: I am the Collection Manager of the Business Administration Division for the plaintiff and custodian of plaintiff's Workers' Compensation Division Accounts Receivable records. Plaintiff's records show that "Proposed and Final Order Declaring Noncompliance and Assessing a Civil Penalty", Number 20877-C was issued to defendants. A certified true copy of the Order is attached.

More than 20 days have elapsed since the defendants received the Order and the defendants have not requested a hearing to contest any matter therein. The penalty proposed in the Order became final on May 4, 1995, by operation of ORS 656.740(1).

Pursuant to ORS 656.735(5) and 82.010, there is now due and owing to the plaintiff by the defendants jointly and severally a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00 plus interest thereon at the rate of nine percent per annum from May 14, 1995, until paid, plus the costs of recording the Order.

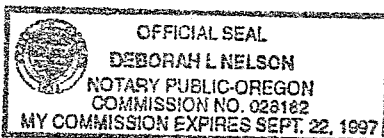

PROPOSED AND FINAL ORDER
ASSESSING A CIVIL PENALTY
(Noncomplying Employer,
Compensable Injury)
Order No. 20877-C

To: SUSAN E GREEN & RODNEY L GREEN

VIOLATION: A noncomplying employer is subject to a civil penalty as provided by ORS 656.735(3), (4), if a subject worker receives a compensable injury while in the employ of the noncomplying employer.

FINDINGS: On November 28, 1994, the Department issued an Order declaring SUSAN E GREEN & RODNEY L GREEN to be noncomplying from September 5, 1993 to June 14, 1994. The Order became final on December 20, 1994.

During the period the above-named employer was a Noncomplying Employer, a subject worker, Ver1 N Falk, on June 9, 1994, sustained a compensable injury; and such determination of compensable injury was final on January 20, 1995.

ORDER: Therefore, a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00 is hereby assessed against SUSAN E GREEN & RODNEY L GREEN.

NOTICE

If you disagree with the above findings, order, or assessment, you may request a hearing. Your request must be in writing, directed to the Department of Consumer and Business Services, Workers' Compensation Division, Labor & Industries Building, Salem, OR 97310. The request should state your grounds for disagreement and must be received by the department within 20 days after you receive this order. If you do not file a request for a hearing within the time allowed, this order will become final by operation of ORS 656.740 and thereafter shall not be subject to review by any agency or court.
