THIS TRUST DEED, made this 16TH day of June, 1917 between John T. Stilwell & Lois A. Stilwell , Tenants by Entirety as Grantor, AmeriTitle, as Trustee, and Running Y Resort, Inc., an Oregon Corporation, as Beneficiary, WITNESSETH:

Granfor irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to Trustee in trust, with power of sale, the property in Klamath County, Oregon described as: Lot 116 of flunning Y Resort, Phase Phase 2 Plat, recorded in Klamath Churty, Oregon.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging or in anywise now or hereafter

appartaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with said real estate

FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING PERFORMANCE of each agreement of grantor herein contained and payment of the sum of \$45,520.00, Forty Five Thousand Five Hundred Twenty And No/100's Dollars, with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to beneficiary or order and made by grantor, the final payment of principal and interest hereof, if not sconer paid, to be due and payable 15 years

The date of maturity of the debt secured by this instrument is the date, stated at love, on which the final installment of said note becomes due and payable. In the event the within described property, or any part thereof, or any interest therein is sold, agreed to be sold, conveyed, assigned or alienated by the grantor without first having obtained the written consent or approval of the bineficiary, then, at the beneficiary's option, all obligations secured by this instrument, irrelipective of the maturity dates expressed therein, or herein, shall become immediately due and payable. The above described real property is not currently used for agricultural, whiter or grazing purposes.

To protect the security of this trust deed, grantor agrees:

1. To protect, preserve and maintain said property in good condition and regair, not to remove or demolish any building or improvement thereon; not to commit or permit any waste of said property.

2. To complete or restore promptly and in good and workmanlike manner any building or improvement which may be constructed, durnaged or

destroyed thereon, and pay when due till costs incurred therefore.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; if the beneficiary so requests, to Join in executing such financing statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code as the beneficiary may require and to pay for filing same in the proper 5 public office or offices, as well as the cost of all lien searches made by filing officing or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the beneficiary.

4. To provide and continuously maintain insurance on the buildings now or himselfer erected on the said premises against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in an amount not less than \$ _0_ written in companies acceptable to the beneficiary. with loss payable to the latter, all policies of insurance shall be delivered to the baneficiary as soon as insured; if the grantor shall fail for any reason to procure any such insurance and to deliver said policies to the beneficiary at least fifteen days prior to the expiration of any policy of insurance now or hereafter placed on said buildings, the beneficiary may procure the same at grantor's expense. The amount collected under any fire or other insurince policy may be applied by beneficiary upon any indebtedness secured hereby and in such order as beneficiary may determine, or at option of beneficiary the entire amount so collected, or any part thereof, may be released to grantor. Such application or release shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

5. To keep said premises free from construction liens and to pay all taxes, issessments and other charges that may be levied or assessed upon or against said property before any part of such taxes, assessments and other charges become past due or delinquent and promptly deliver receipts therefor to beneficiary; should the grantor fail to make payment of any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, liens or other charges payable by grantor, either by direct payment or by providing beneficiary with funds with which to make such payment, beneficiary may, at its option, make payment thereof, and the amount so paid, with interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby, together with the obligations described in paragraphs 6 and 7 of this trust deed. shall be added to and become a part of the debt secured by this trust deed, without visiver of any rights arising from breach of any of the coverients hereof and for such payments, with interest as aforesaid, the property hereinbefore described, as well as the grantor, shall be bound to the same exter t that they are bound for the payment of the obligation herein described, and all such payments shall be immediately due and payable without notice, and the nonpayment thereof shall, at the option of the beneficiary, render all sums secured by this trust deed immediately due and payable and constitute a breach of this trust deed.

6. To pay till costs, fees and expenses of this trust including the cost of title search as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred

in connection with or in enforcing this obligation and trustee's and attorney's feet actually incurred.

7. To appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect this security rights or powers of beneficiary or trustee; and in any suit, action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear, including any sult for the foreclosure of this deed, to pay all costs and expenses, including evidence of title and the beneficiary's of trustee's attorney's fees, the amount of attorney's fees mentioned in this paragraph 7 in all cases shall be fixed by the trial court and in the event of an appeal from any judgment or decree of the trial court, grantor further agrees to pay such sum as the appealate court shall adjudge reasonable as the beneficiary's or trustee's attorney's fees on such appeal.

It is mutually agreed that:

8. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, beneficiary shall have the right. if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the monies payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and atterney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees, both in the trial and appellate courts, necessarily paid or incurred by beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute

proceedings, any tire parameter applied upon the indebtedness secured network, and grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such according such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, proriptly upon beneficiary's request.

9. At any time and from time to time upon written request of beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for encorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any purson for the payment of the indebtedness, trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any restrictions thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lieu or charge thereof, (d) reconvey, without unirranty, all or any part of the property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto," and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's fees for any of the services mentioned in this panagraph shall be not less than \$5.

10. Upon any default by granter hereunder, beneficiary may at any time wit your notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness: liereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property or any part thereof, in its own name sue or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney's fees upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as beneficiary may

11. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits, or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of this property, and the application or release thereof as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereuniter or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

Upon default by grantor is payment of any indebbalness secured hilleby or in his performance of any agreement herounder, the bigneticiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. In such all event the beneficiary at his election may proceed to foreclose this trust deed in equity as a mortgage or direct the trustee to foreclose it is trust deed by abvertisement and sale. In the latter event the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to sell the said described real property to satisfy the obligation secured hereby when upon the trusted shall fix the time and place of sale,, give notice it erest as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS88.735 to 83.795.
- 13. After the trustee has communical foreclosure by advertisement and sale, and at any time prior to 5 days before the data the trustee conducts the sale, the granior or any other person so privileged by ORS88.753, may cure the default or defaults. If the default consists of a failure to pay, when due, sums secured by the trust deed, the default may be cured by paying the entire amount due at the time of the cure other than such portion as would not then be due had no default occurred. Any other default that is capable of being cured may be cured by tendering the performance required under the subligation or trust deed.
