ORDER & DECREE 98-024

- 1. That portion of Klamath Memorial Park lying to the east of Memorial Drive has not been and is not being used for the internment of human remains; and
- 2. That notice of the hearing was duly published in the Herald & News and posted on the portion of property from which the dedication is to be removed as required by ORS 97.440(2).

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY ORDER AND DECREE AS FOLLOWS:

The dedication set forth in Volume 8, sheet 5 (recorded 12-24-43) and in Volume 8, sheet 8 (recorded 12-13-46) in Town Plats records of the County Clerk as applies to all that portion of Klamath Memorial Park lying east of the present Memorial Drive (formerly Cumberland) is hereby removed.

This order and decree shall be recorded with the County Clerk.




