## A SPECIAL ORDINANCE VACATING STREETS WITHIN A PORTION OF THE DIXON ADDITION

WHEREAS, the owner of property adjacent to said public streets, due to a replat of a portion of the Dixon Adidtion, desires to vacate Gibbs Street, a portion of Wendling Street, a portion of Williams Avenue, a portion of Warring Street, and the alley between Wendling, Williams, Gibbs and Warring; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on June 23, 1997, pursuant to applicable laws, at which time all objections with reference to said proposed vacation and were considered by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hearing notice having been duly given, did hold a public hearing on July 28, 1997; on the record of the Planning Commission on the annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted the findings of the Planning Commission, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as Exhibit "B", determining the annexation to be in compliance with the Comprehensive Plan and Community Development Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such record and hearing, the City Council has determined the vacation to be in compliance with the Community Development Ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan; NOW THEREFORE,



## Exhibit "B"

The following addresses the criteria specific to section 13.025 of the City's Community Development Ordinance. In applying the facts to the criteria, specific cross references may have been made; however, the facts separately set for forth are generally applicable to more than one criteria and therefore, should be treated as cumulative and supplementary.

- 1. <u>Criteria</u>. The consent of the owners of the requisite area has been obtained.
  - Finding. Consent has been obtained from all those required by law.
- 2. <u>Criteria</u>: The notice of the proposed vacation has been duly given.

Finding Notice of the proposed vacation was mailed to 80 property owners on May 30, 1997, and on July 11, 1997, and published in the Herald & News on the same days.

3. <u>Criteria.</u> The public interest will be prejudiced by vacation of such plat or part thereof.

<u>Finding</u>: No evidence has been submitted to show that the public interest will be prejudiced by the vacation of the street and alley. Currently the street and alley are unimproved and are not used for access to any lot.

4. <u>Criteria.</u> The proposed vacation conforms to the Comprehensive Plan, all applicable street plans, and all applicable provisions of Chapters 10 to 14.

Finding. The proposed vacation does conform to the Comprehensive Plan, all applicable street plans, and all applicable provisions of Chapters 10 to 14.
