The Klamath County Planning Department staff report was received. The Applicant appeared. Based upon the evaluation of the Staff Report and consideration of the other evidence received, the Hearings Officer makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and makes the following decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Applicant wants to establish a Won Farm Home on 6.8 acres zoned EFU-CG/AG east of Highway 97, south of South Chiloquin

Road, west bank of the Williamson River, a portion of Government Lot 20, Section 4,T J5S, R 7E, T.A. 3507-04-700. Authority for permitting the proposed use is Klamath County Land Development Code Article 54.
