Respondent shall cause a septic system to be installed and obtain approval by January 1, 1998 and obtain a construction or placement permit by April 1, 1998. In the event Respondent fails to comply this order the Code Enforcement Officer shall cite Respondent to appear in Wood River District Court to show cause why she should not be required to comply with this order. Bail to be set at \$1000.00.
