This matter came before Michael L. The Klamath County Planning Department file and all the exhibits and other contents therein is incorporated by this reference into this matter. The Klamath County Planning Department staff report was received. Applicant appeared. Based upon the evaluation of the Staff Report and consideration of the other evidence received, the Hearings Officer makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and makes the following decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Applicant wants to establish a Lot of Record forest dwelling on 5.69 acres zoned FR, Forestry/Range at Gerber Reservoir. The

subject property location is north of Ben Hall Creek, at Gerber Reservoir and is described as a portion of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 S35, T35S, R13E. T.A. 3813-35-3501. The property is within the Bonanza/BIM Fire District and is accessed by a county road. The Timber Rate Site is poor. Authority for permitting the proposed use is Klamath County Land Development Code Article 55 (ORD 44.39).

CONCLUSION

The record reveals that the proposed use meets the criteria set out in L.D.C. Article 55, Sections 55.060 and 54.070 Article 44, Section 44.030.

ORDER

The requested Conditional Use Permit No. 89-97 is granted subject to compliance by obtaining all required permits and approvals from the Klamath County Building, Health and Planning Departments and compliance with the requirements of the Klamath County Land Development Code Article 55 Section 55.070 (C) and OAR Chapter 340 for On-Site Sewage Disposal.
