According to the provisions of ORS 368.341(3) and ORS 368.351, a petition containing the acknowledged signatures of the owners of 100% of the property abutting the public property described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, proposed to be vacated and indicating said owners' approval of the proposed vacation was filed with the Board of Commissioners on August 15, 1997.

Thereafter, the Public Works Director filed with the Commissioners a written report containing 5 the required information of ORS 368.346(1), finding the vacation to be in the public interest.

Now, after fully considering the report and other documentation presented, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the vacation of a a portion of Crosby Street, located in the SW 1/4 of Section 2, T. 39S., R.9E., W.M., in Klamath County, Oregon, as described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is in the public interest and finds that the petition should be granted and that the real property be vacated, subject to easements for all public utilities and an easement to construct and operate an irrigation line in the vacated area.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition is granted and that the portion described herein is vacated, as said vacation in the public interest. It is further ordered that pursuant to ORS 365.366(1)(d) the vacated property is vested in the owners of the abutting property by extension of their property boundaries.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs resulting from the approved vacation is determined to be in the sum of \$100.00 and that the persons liable for payment of the costs are the petitioners, who have paid the above mentioned sum on August 15, 1997.

SUBJECT: VACATION OF A PORTION OF CROSBY STREET IN THE PLAT OF ST. FRANCIS PARK, KLAMATH COUNTY, OREGON

At the August 20, 1997 Action Agenda Meeting, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the vacation petition from Andrew Gigler. The Director of Public Works was directed to prepare this report by Order #98-028.

Notice of the pending vacation proceedings was provided to all utilities with facilities in the area. U.S. West Communications, South Suburban Sanitary District and Pacific Power and Light operate facilities in the area to be vacated.

The portion of Crosby Street proposed to be vacated has been improved and maintained by Mr. Gigler. It is currently being used to access mobile homes in the Silver Tip Trailer Court, which is owned by Mr. Gigler.

This portion of Crosby Street has not been used by the general public for many years and is not needed as part of the County Road System. Returning the property to the tax rolls would benefit the public.

The petition contains 100% of abutting property owners' signatures. I recommend the portion of Crosby Street described in the petition be vacated.

The order should stipulate that the vacation is subject to easements for all public utilities and an easement to construct and operate an irrigation line in the vacated area.
