Quitclaim Deed

The UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Regional Resources Manager, Mid-Pacific Region, Bureau of Reclamation, for the Secretary of the Interior, in pursuance of the Act of Congress approved June 17, 1902, (32 Stat. 388) and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto and for valuable consideration previously received, does and hereby quitclaims, releases, and conveys to Steven R. And Jacqueline Walker, husband and wife, their successors and assigns, all of its right, title, and interest it may have in and to the following:

A parcel of land in the Northeast-quarter Southeast-quarter (NE4SE4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-nine (39) South, Range Nine (9) East, Willamette Meridian, County of Klamath, State of Oregon, containing an area of 0.6 acres, more or less, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-nine (39) South, Range Nine (9) East, thence North 0° 15' East 1,734.7 feet along the East line of said Section 26 to the North boundary of Tax Lot 1200, thence North 90° West 80.13 feet along said Tax Lot boundary to a point on the Easterly right-of-way of the abandoned portion of the 1-C Drain right-of-way, said point being the true point of beginning (Point B);

Thence North 48° 48' West 513.43 feet to the Easterly right-of-way line of the existing 1-C Drain; thence South 19° 48' East 19.0 feet along said right-of-way; thence South 6° 25' 45" West 67.5 feet along said right-of-way; thence South 48° 48' East 384.49 feet; thence North 90°' East 91.0 feet along the North boundary of Tax Lot 1200 to the true point of beginning.

Said parcel is shown on "Exhibit A" (Reclamation Map No. 12-201-5438), enclosed herewith and made a part hereof.

SUBJECT to the existing rights-of-way in favor of the public or third parties for highways, roads, railroads, telegraph, telephone, and electrical transmission lines and canals, laterals, flumes,

This instrument is a replacement quitclaim deed for the original quitclaim deed given to L. C. Wicks et ux on June 9, 1964. Said original deed was never recorded and could not be located. Steven R. And Jacqueline Walker, are apparently the successors in interest to the surrounding property. The original consideration for the United States was a quitclaim deed for a relocated portion of the I-C Drain given by Larry C. Wicks and Ruby Lee Wicks, husband and wife, on January 20, 1966 and recorded in Book M-66 page 6438 of Klamath County records.
