This matter came before Michael L. Brant, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon, on November 7, 1997 in the Klamath County Museum Meeting Room in Klamath Falls, Oregon. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related statutes and ordinances. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Mr. Kim Lundahl and the recording secretary was Assistant Planner Karen Burg. The Klamath County Planning Department file and all the exhibits and other contents therein is incorporated by this reference into this matter. The Klamath County Planning Department staff report was received. Based upon the evaluation of the staff report and consideration of the evidence received, the hearings officer makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and makes the following decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Respondent has been and is ~~camping~~, as defined by KCLDC Article 11, on property not zoned for such use. The Respondent has failed to comply with the conditions of approval for TUP 2-97. The subject property is identified as Lot 22, Blk 121 KPFE #4.

CONCLUSION

The Respondent is in violation.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that Respondent shall submit proof of authorization to install and complete installation of a septic system by January 1, 1998 or vacate the property. Respondent shall submit proof by March 1, 1998 that a development permit has been granted or vacate the property. Respondent fails to comply with this order the Code Enforcement Officer shall cite Respondent to appear in Wood River District Court to show cause why Respondent should not be required to comply with this order. Bail to be set at \$1000.00.
