The Respondents live in a travel trailer, use a chemical toilet and have all was water pumped by Jefferson State Sanitation. The site has been approved for installation of a Cap and Fill sanitation system. The ground is presently frozen and covered with snow.

CONCLUSION

The ground conditions will not permit installation of the system at this time

ORDER

The Respondents shall apply for a Temporary Use Permit and Septic Installation Permit by February 1, 1998 or vacate the property. If the Respondents so apply then they shall install the permitted system by May 1, 1998 or vacate the property.
