ORDER APPROVING WAIVER OF ACCOUNTING: AMOUNTS PAYABLE AS STATUTORY AND EXTRAORDINARY COMPENSATION TO THE ADMINISTRATOR'S ATTORNEYS, AND FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION OF ESTATE

Marc A. Miltenberger, as administrator of the estate of Virginia Miltenberger, deceased, having filed herein on July 9, 1997, his Petition For Waiver Of Accounting, Order Approving Amounts As Statutory And Extraordinary Compensation To The Administrator's Attorneys And For Final Distribution Of Estate, and the Petition having come on regularly to be heard this day, the court, from proof made to the satisfaction of the court and from the evidence adduced at the hearing, now makes the following findings:

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- 1. Notice of the petition and of the filing thereof and of the time and lace set for the hearing thereof has been given in the manner and for the time required by law.
- 2. Virginia Miltenberger died intestate on June 21, 1994, a resident of Berkeley, Alameda County, California, and left an estate in Alameda County, California. By order of the above-entitled court dated July 12, 1994, Marc A. Miltenberger was appointed special administrator of the estate of the decedent. Marc A. Miltenberger qualified as such special administrator and Letters of Administration were issued to him on July 12, 1994. By order of the above entitled court dated August 8, 1994, petitioner was appointed administrator of the estate of the decedent and Letters of Administration were issued to him on August 9, 1994. Bond was not required. At all times since August 9, 1994, petitioner has been, and now is, the duly appointed, qualified and acting administrator of the decedent.
- 3. Notice to Creditors was published for the period and in the manner prescribed by law. Within 30 days after the completion of publication of Notice to Creditors, there was filed with the Clerk of the Court an affidavit showing publication of Notice to Creditors in the manner and form required by law. More than four months have elapsed since the issuance of Letters of Administration in this estate and since the first publication of Notice to Creditors. All known and reasonably ascertainable creditors of the estate described in Probate Code §9050 received the notice described in Probate Code §9052 or are within the class of creditors described in Probate Code §9054. The time for filing

claims has expired. The following creditor claims were presented against the estate:

- (a) On November 4, 1994, a creditor's claim was presented to the estate by Collection Bureau of San Jose, assignee of Alta Bates Medical Center for medical services in the amount of \$884.34. This creditor's claim was paid in full.
- (b) On August 24, 1994, two creditor's claims were presented to the estate by Fitzgerald, Abbott & Beardsley LLP for services rendered as attorneys for the conservator. One creditor's claim was presented in the amount of "unknown" and the other creditor's claim was presented in the amount of \$2,020.45. Both creditor's claims were withdrawn by Fitzgerald, Abbott & Beardsley LLP.

All debts of the decedent and of the estate, and all expenses of administration, except for attorneys' fees and further accountant's fees, have been paid.

4. The following request for special notice was filed in this proceeding:

James C. Jones, on behalf of Collection Bureau of San Jose. This request was withdrawn on March 21, 1995.

6. On October 2, 1996, the administrator filed herein his Complete Inventory and Appraisement of the assets of the estate of the decedent. The value of the assets constituting the probate estate of the decedent, as determined by the administrator and the duly appointed probate referee, is \$356,388.56. The assets of the estate consist entirely of the decedent's separate property.

- 7. The administrator filed a change of ownership statement with the County Recorder of each county in California in which the decedent owned real property at the time of her death. A property tax certification was filed on July 13, 1994.
- 8. No personal property taxes were due from the decedent or her estate.
- 9. No Federal or California estate tax returns were required to be filed by reason of the death of the decedent.
- 10. The administrator has caused to be prepared and filed all income tax returns, both state and federal, that were required to be filed for the decedent and for her estate. All known taxes due from the decedent or her estate, including federal and state income taxes, have been paid or provided for. Closing fiduciary income tax returns will be filed following the distribution of the estate.
- 11. All debts of the decedent, all county, state and federal taxes finally determined to be payable by the decedent or her estate, and all expenses of the administration of the estate so far incurred, except for statutory attorneys' fees and accountant's fees, have been fully paid or provided for. The estate is now in a condition to be closed.

- 12. Marc A. Miltenberger, as administrator, has filed no account herein because Marc A. Miltenberger, in his individual capacity, and Janis Miltenberger are entitled to receive the entire estate of the decedent; and each has waived an accounting in this matter.
- 13. It is proper that the court should authorize the administrator to retain a reserve of \$5,000.00 for the payment of the preparation of final fiduciary income tax returns, the payment of closing costs, and the payment of any tax deficiencies.
- 14. The administrator has waived his compensation for services rendered as administrator of the estate.
- 15. The sum approved in this order for payment to the law firm of Fitzgerald, Abbott & Beardsley LLP for their ordinary services as attorneys for the administrator is the proper statutory amount.
- 16. The sum approved in this order for payment to the law firm of Fitzgerald. Abbott & Beardsley LLP for their extraordinary services to the estate in connection with the sale of real property is a reasonable sum.
- 17. The decedent died intestate. The decedent was a widow at the date of her death. The decedent's children, Marc A. Miltenberger and Janis Miltenberger, survived the decedent, are now living and are adults. Pursuant to Probate Code § 6402(a), the entire estate of the decedent is distributable equally to the decedent's children, Janis Miltenberger and Marc A. Miltenberger.
- 18. By virtue of the laws of the State of California applicable to the distribution of the decedent's estate, the entire

estate of the decedent in the possession or under the control of the administrator at the time the decree of final distribution, consisting of cash in the approximate amount of \$287,512.14, shall be made herein, exclusive of the amounts approved as payable to the administrator's attorneys and exclusive of the reserve, is distributable in equal shares to Janis Miltenberger and Marc A. Miltenberger.

- 19. By virtue of the laws of the State of California applicable to the distribution of the decedent's estate, any and all property not known or discovered at the time the decree of final distribution of the estate is made, belonging to the decedent or her estate or in which the decedent or her estate may have any interest, and any unexpended portion of the reserve, is distributable in equal shares to Janis Miltenberger and Marc A. Miltenberger.
- 20. The Petition is verified, and all of the allegations thereof are true. Now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the administrator is authorized to retain a reserve in the sum of \$5,000.00 for the costs of preparation of the final fiduciary income tax returns, the payment of closing costs and the payment of any tax deficiencies.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the sum of \$7,477.77 be, and it is hereby, approved as the amount payable to the law firm of Fitzgerald, Abbott & Beardsley LLP as statutory compensation for their ordinary services as attorneys for the administrator and \$750.00 as extraordinary compensation.
