QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS that Klamath County, a Political sub-division of the State of Oregon hereinafter called grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto James L. Treasure & Cherice F. Treasure, as Tenants by the Entirety hereinafter called grantee, and unto grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, all of the grantor's right, title and interest in that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining, situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 2, Block 115, Buena Vista Addition to the City of Klamath Falls situated in Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon.

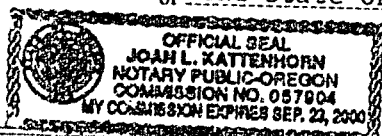
