#### 6. ORDER

## THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The hearings officer finds that as a matter of law the Respondent is in violation of the Klamath County Land Development Code.

The enforcement officer is directed to cite the Respondent to appear in the Wood River Justice Court with bail to be set by the court if all violations are not remedied by June 30, 1998.

The Respondents shall bring proof of all necessary permits and inspections to the Klamath County Enforcement Officer by June 30, or shall cease camping and to remove all un-permitted structures and personal property no later than June 30, 1998.
