#### CONFORMANCE WITH RELEVANT KLAMATH COUNTY POLICIES:

Notice was sent out to 18 surrounding property owners as well as to 4 agencies of concern. To date, the following agency comment has been received:

- KCFD No. 1 has no concerns with the proposal.
- South Suburban Sanitary District will require a system development fee of \$312.50 prior to connection to the District's system. The existing service line can be used for the new residence.

The review criteria of Section 44.030 of the Land Development Code requires that:

- A. The use complies with policies of the Comprehensive Plan.

As the requested use is a conditionally permitted use within the IH zone as adopted as part of the Comprehensive Plan, applicant is in compliance with this criterion.

- B. The use is in conformance with all other required standards and criteria

The IH zone allows as a conditional use, a worker residence. The applicant meets this requirement as the appropriate CUP application was made and required notice was mailed.

- C. The location, size, design, and operating characteristics of the proposed use will not have a significant adverse impact on the livability, value or appropriate development of abutting properties and the surrounding area.

Based on this review criteria, and in light of the significant number of letters received objecting to this application, this matter shall be referred per LDC Article 22, Section 22.050B to a full quasi-judicial hearing before the Klamath County Hearings Officer on Friday, September 18, 1998, at 9:00 a.m. The meeting location will be at the Klamath County Museum meeting room, 1451 Main Street, Klamath Falls.
