1.1 Payment and Performance. Grantor shall pay to Credit Union all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.

- 2.1 Possession. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Income
- 2.2 Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value
- 2.3 Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or
- 2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.

2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.

- 2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

 2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary.
- 2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any Improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay that all custs and expenses in connection with the work.

3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall

3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to such improvements. 14. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. (f) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Credit Union or its designee may vote on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners, pursuant to the power of attorney granted Credit Union in Section 16.2.

(g) Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note.

14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Safe. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.

14.4 Walver, Election of Remedies. A warver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prej

under this Deed of Trust.

14.5 Attormays' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a lawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgment collection actions.

15. Notice. 15. Notice.

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. 17.2 Perhault, if the payment of any installment of principal or any interest on the prior indebtedness is not made within the time required by the Agreement evidencing such indebtedness, or should an event of default occur under the instrument securing such indebtedness and not be cured during any applicable grace period therein, then your action or inaction shall entitle the Credit Union to terminate and accelerate the indebtedness and pursue any of its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

17.2 No Modifications. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Deed of Trust by which that egreement ic modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Grantor shall nother request nor accept any future advances under a prior mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement without the prior written consent of Credit Union.
