## CONSTRUCTION DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED SEPTEMBER 2, 1998, among Melvin L. Stewart and Robert J. Bogatay, Vested as: Melvin L. Stewart and Robert J. Bogatay, tenants in common, each as to an undivided 1/2 interest, whose address to 5761 Glenridge Way, Klamath Falls, OR 97603 (referred to below as "Grantor"); South Valley Bank & Trust, whose address is P O Box 5210, Klamath Falls, OR 97601 (referred to below sometimes as "Lender" and sometimes as "Beneficiary"); and William P. Brandsness, whose address is 411 Pine Street, Klamath Falls, OR 97601 (referred to below as "Trustee").

CONVEYANCE AND GRANT. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustee for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or efficed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits retailing to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Klamath County, State of Oregon (the "Real Property"):

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 6100 Wesgo Drive, Klamath Falls, OR 97603. The Real Property tex Identification number is 3909-01600-00900.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender (also known as Beneficiary in this Deed of Trust) all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all present and future leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property defined below.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, replacements and other construction on the Real Property

Indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lander to discharge obligations of Granter or expenses incurred by Trustee or Lander to enforce obligations of Granter under this Deed of Trust. together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Deed of Trust. Powers of Trustee. Successor Trustee. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any iten which has priority over this Deed of Trust shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Deed of Trust. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender and Trustee informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust:

Amandments. This Dead of Trust, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Dead of Trust. No alteration of or amandment to this Dead of Trust shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amandment.

Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than Grantor's residence, Grantor shall furnish to Lender, upon request, a certified statement of not operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such form and detail as Lender shall require. "Not operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

Applicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Oregon. This Deed of Trust shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the Isws of the State of Oregon.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Deed of Trust are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Deed of Trust.

Mergar. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Deed of Trust with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Deed of Trust.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Deed of Trust to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Deed of Trust In all other respects shall remain valid and enforceabile.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lenders and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever corsent by Lender is required in this Deed of Trust, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

COMMERCIAL DEED OF TRUST. Grantor agrees with Lender that this Deed of Trust is a commercial deed of trust and that Grantor will not change the use of the Property without Lender's prior written consent.
