1. SCOPE OF THE HEARING:

The referenced case, a Site Plan Approval allowing the addition of eight 1440 Sq Ft rental units to the existing Lodge, was approved May 18, 1998. The appellants filed their appeals of this decision in a timely manner. The Board of County Commissioners September 22, 1998 was informed the applicant wished to withdraw the application and vacate the May 18 approval.

The appeal was NOT heard because of the applicants stated desire to vacate the May 18, 1998 approval decision.


2. THOSE WHO PARTICIPATED:


