DECLARATION ANNEXING PHASE THE RECEIVED THE RESERVED THE OF EAGLES LANDING

TO

RUNNING Y RANCH RESORT

THIS DECLARATION is made this And day of WOOT , 1998, by RUNNING Y RESORT. INC., an Oregon corporation ("Declaraget").

## RECITALS

- A. Declarant is the Declarant under that certain Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions and Easements for Running Y Ranch Resort dated August 2, 1996 and recorded August 2, 1996 in the records of Kiamath County, Oregon, in Volume M96, Page 23548 (the "Master Declaration").
- B. Declarant wishes to annex the real property described on attached Exhibit A (the "Additional Property") to the Master Declaration and to designate the Additional Property as Phase 2 of a Project known as "Eagles Landing".
- C. The Master Declaration provides that additional properties may be ennexed to Running Y Ranch Resort pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.2 of the Master Declaration. Declarant wishes to annex the Additional Property to Running Y Ranch Resort upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Declaration.

NOW. THEREFORE. Declarant does hereby declare and provide as follows:

- **DEFINITIONS.** As used in this Declaration, the terms set forth below shall have the following meanings:
- Additional Property. Additional Property means all the real property described in the attached Exhibit A.
- Master Declaration. Master Declaration means the Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions and Easements for Running Y Rauch Resort, dated August 2, 1996 and recorded August 2, 1996, in the records of Klamath County, Oregon, in Volume M96, Page 23548.
- 1.3 Incorparation by Reference. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Declaration, each of the terms defined in Article 1 of the Master Declaration shall have the meanings set forth in such Article.
- ANNEXATION. The Additional Property is hereby sumexed to Running Y Ranch Resort and made subject to the Master Declaration on the terms and conditions set forth in this Declaration.

- 3. PRINTELE The Additional Property shall be Passe 3 of the Project known as Eagles Landing for purposes of the Master Declaration.
- 4. LAND CLASSIFICATIONS. The Additional Property is included in one or another of the following classifications:
- 4.1 Resistential Lots. Pletted lots numbered 310 through 329 within the plat of Running Y Resort Phase 4, IST Addition and lots numbered 330 through 350 within the plat of Running Y Resort Phase 4, 2ND Addition, but excluding any tract labeled as "Master Common Area" or "Common Lot" on such plat, shall be Residential Lots as defined in Section 1.34 of the Master Declaration.
- 4.2 <u>Common Areas</u>. Merlin Way, Falcon Drive and Cormorant Loop shall be Common Areas as defined in Section 1.8 of the Master Declaration.
- defined as Residential Lots or Common Areas in Sections 4.1 or 4.2 above, shall be Project Common Areas as defined in Section 1.28 of the Master Declaration. Within the Project Common Area as shown on the plat of Running Y Resort, Phase 4, IST Addition, the Owner of each adjacent Lot shall have the use of a driveway crossing Project Common Areas and connecting to each Lot. Within the Project Common Areas "B" and "C" as shown on the plat of Running Y Resort, Phase 4, 2ND Addition, the Owner of each adjacent Lot shall have the use of a driveway crossing Project Common Areas and connecting to each Lot. Within the Project Common Areas and connecting to each Lot. Within the Project Common Area "A" as shown on the plat of Running Y Resort, Phase 4, 2ND Addition, each Owner shall have the use of a parking space or spaces which will be assigned to such Lot by the Association and will be connected to such Lot by a pathway.
- 4.4 Common Essement Areas. The sewer essement located on Common Area "B" and bordering platted Lots 310 329 as shown on the plat of Running Y Resort, Phase 4, 1ST Addition along with the utility essement adjacent to Cooper's Hawk Road on Common Area "C" as shown on the plat of Running Y Resort, Phase 4, 2ND Addition shall be Common Essement Areas as defined in Section 1.9 of the Master Declaration.
- 5. MASTER DECLARATION. The Additional Property shall be subject to all of the terms and provisions of the Master Declaration, except that Section 7.16 (Minimum Dwelling Size) and Section 7.20 (Time-Sharing or Fractional Interest Ownership) shall not be applicable to the Additional Property.
- 6. <u>ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS</u> The Additional Property shall be subject to the following additional restrictions:
- Occupants of Living Units shall exercise extreme care not to make noises which may disturb occupants of cher Living Units. Except with the consent of the Association and the Architectural Review Committee, no exterior lighting or noise-making devices shall be installed or maintained on any Lot within Eagles Landing. Owners shall not tamper with exterior lighting except to replace expended builts with similar new bulbs.
- 6.2 Windows, Decks, Porches, Outside Walls and Varies. In order to preserve the attractive appearance of Eagles Landing, the Association may regulate the nature of items which

may be placed in or on windows decks, entry porches, cutside walls and yards so as to be visible from outside of the Lot. Gamesus, rega, bandry and raker similar means may not be lang from windows, facades, porches or decks.

- 6.3 Alterations. Owners are expressly prohibited from painting or changing the exterior of the building or other structure without written permission of the Architectural Review Committee and the Association. No structure may be installed outside of the Living Unit except structures, including without limitation fences, installed with written approval of the Association and Architectural Committee.
- 6.4 Insurance. Nothing shall be done or kept on any Lot or Project Common Area which will increase the cost of insurance on the Living Units or Project Common Areas. No Owner shall permit anything to be done or kept in his Living Unit or in the Project Common Areas which would result in cancellation of insurance on any Lot or any part of the Project Common Areas.
- 6.5 Landscape. All exterior landscape installations and plantings must be approved by the Association and the Architectural Review Committee.
- 6.6 Project Policies and Procedures. In addition, the Association from time to time may adopt, modify or revoke such policies and procedures governing the conduct of persons in the operation and use of Lots, Living Units and Project Common Areas within Eagles Landing as it may deem necessary or appropriate in order to assure the peaceful and orderly use and enjoyment of Eagles Landing. A copy of the Policies and Procedures, upon adoption, and a copy of each amendment, modification or revocation thereof, shall be furnished by the Association Board of Directors to each Owner within Eagles Landing and shall be binding upon all Owners and occupants of all Lots within Eagles Landing upon the date of delivery. The method of adoption of such Policies and Procedures shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Association.
- 6.7 Exterior Maintenance. The Association shall be responsible for maintaining the Project Common Areas of Eagles Landing, the paved driveways, parking lots and paved pathways connecting to each Living Unit, the roof and exterior structure of each Living Unit within Eagles Landing (including painting), septic tanks and septic tank pumps, and all landscaping and landscape irrigation systems (including water and power for such systems) within Project Common Areas and Lots.
- 6.8 Insurance: The Association, through the Board of Directors, shall obtain and maintain at all times and shall pay for out of Project Assessments the following insurance covering both the Project Common Areas and the Living Units within Eagles Landing, including fixtures, equipment, and other property which would ordinarily be required to be covered by a holder of a first mortgage:
- (a) Insurance including, but not limited to, fire, extended coverage, vandalism, and malicious mischief and
- (b) Insurance covering the legal liability of the Association, the Owners individually and the manager, including but not limited to, the Association Board of Directors, the public and the Owners and their invitees or tenants, incident to ownership, supervision, control or use of Eagles Landing. There may be excluded from the policy required under this subsection, coverage of an Owner, other than coverage as a mamber of the Association or Board of

Directors, too liability prising out of the acts of omessions of that Guiner sail the liability incident to the ownership or use of the part of kingles Landing as to which that Owner has the exclusive use or occupancy. Liability insurance required under this subsection shall be issued on a comprehensive liability basis and shall provide a cross liability endorsement providing that the rights of named insured under the policy shall not prejudice any action against another named insured.

Notwithstanding any of the forgoing provisions and requirements relating to property or liability insurance, there may be named as an insured, on behalf of the Association, the Association's authorized representative, including any trustee with whom the Association may enter into any insurance trust agreement or any successor to such trustee (each of whom shall be referred to in this Declaration as the "Insurance Trustee"), who shall have exclusive authority to negotiate losses under any policy providing such property or liability insurance.

Each owner appoints any Insurance Trustee or substitute Insurance Trustee designated by the Association, as an attorney-in-fact for the purpose of purchasing and maintaining such insurance, including: the collection and appropriate disposition of the proceeds thereof, the negotiation of losses and execution of releases of liability; the execution of all documents; and the performance of all other acts necessary to accomplish such purpose. The Association or any Insurance Trustee shall reveive, hold, or otherwise properly dispose of any proceeds of insurance in trust for Owners and there first mortgage holders as their interest may appear.

- 6.9 <u>Damage or Destruction</u>. If any Living Unit within Eagles Landing is destroyed and the Owners of all Living Units situated in the affected building elect not to rebuild and if the election not to rebuild is approved by a seventy-five percent (75%) vote of the Owners within Eagles Landing, the affected Lots shall be cleared of debris and Living Units of an alternate design may be constructed subject to approval of Declarant and the Architectural Review Committee.
- 6.10 <u>Project Assessments.</u> The costs of maintenance and insurance as set forth in Sections 6.7 and 6.8 together with the costs of enforcing the restrictions contained in this Declaration, including reasonable administrative costs relating thereto, shall be assessed to each Lot within Eagles Landing on an equal basis as Project Assessments and enforced as Individual Assessments under the Master Declaration.
- 6.11 Project Association. Declaram, the Association or the Owners within Eagles Landing (by majority vote) may elect to establish a Project Association for Eagles Landing. In such event, Declarant or the Association shall adopt Articles of Incorporation and initial Bylaws for the Project Association and supervise the organization of and election of directors for the Project Association. Upon establishment of the Project Association, the Project Association shall be responsible for enforcement of the restrictions contained in this Declaration in the manner provided in the Master Declaration, adoption of Project Policies and Procedures, maintenance of the Project Common Areas and exterior of Living Units within Eagles Landing as provided in this Declaration, and assessment and collection of Project Assessments in the same manner as provided in the Master Declaration for assessment and collection of assessments thereunder. The Project Association shall have the same classes of membership and the same voting rights as provided in the Master Declaration for the Master Association.

## 7 PARTEMALAS

- 7.1 Party Well Declaration. The dividing wall adjacent to the Living Units situated in the same building is hereby declared to be a party well. The cost of maintaining the party wall shall be borne equally by the Owners of the adjacent Living Units.
- 7.2 Damage to Party Wall. In the event of damage or destruction of any party wall from any cause, other than the negligence of an adjacent Owner, the Association shall repair or rebuild the party wall, and each Owner, his successors and assigns, shall have the right to the full use of the party wall so repaired or rebuilt. If an adjacent Owner's negligence shall cause dransge to or destruction is not covered by insurance, such negligent party shall bear the entire cost of repair or reconstruction. If any negligent Owner shall neglect or refuse to pay his share within fifteen (15) days after written demand by the Association, the Association shall be entitled to have a lien on the Living Unit of the negligent Owner for the amount of such defaulting party's share of the repair or replacement cost. Any such lien may be foreclosed in the same manner as an Ladividual Assessment.
- 7.3 Dristing Through Party Well. With the prior written consent of the Architectural Review Committee, either adjacent Cwner shall have the night to break through the party wall for the purpose of repairing or restoring sewerage, water, or utilities, subject to the obligation to restore the party wall to its previous condition at his own expense and the payment to the adjoining Owner of any damages cased thereby.
- 7.4 Destruction of Living Unit. If one or more of the buildings are damaged, destroyed, or partial condemned, the Association Board of Directors shall immediately proceed to rebuild and restore the building or buildings so damaged, destroyed, or partially condemned so that the same will be returned to substantially the same condition in which the building or buildings existed prior to such damage, destruction, or partial condemnation. Each Living Unit shall have the same vertical and horizontal boundaries as before. If the insurance proceeds are insufficient to rebuild and restore, the Owners shall be liable for assessment for any deficiency.
- 7.5 Essement. No Owner shall alter or change a party wall in any manner, interior decoration excepted. Each party wall shall always remain in its present location. Each adjacent Owner shall have a perpetual easement in that part of the Living Unit of the adjacent Owner on which the party wall is located, for party wall purposes3.
- 8. AMENDMENT. Sections 5 7 of this Declaration may be amended by Declarant at any time prior to the closing of the sale of the first lot in the Additional Property. Thereafter, this Declaration may only be amended by the vote or written consent of Owners owning not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the Lots within Eagles Landing, together with the written consent of the Class B member of the Association, or if a Project Association has been established, the written consent of the Class B member of the Project Association for Eagles Landing, if such Class B membership has not been terminated. Any such Amendment shall become effective only upon recordation in the Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, of a certificate of the President or Secretary of the Association, or of the Project Association if a Project Association has been established, setting forth in full the amendments so approved and certifying that the Amendment has been approved in the manner required by this Declaration. In no event shall such

an Armendment create, limit or diminish special Declarant rights without Declarant's written consent.

BINDING HEXECT. The Additional Property, including all Lots, Common Areas, Common Easement Areas and Project Common Areas therein, shall be held, conveyed, hypothecated, encumbered, used, occupied, and improved only in accordance with the provisions of the Master Declaration, as modified by this instrument, which exceeds a constant
