On February 4, 1998, the board properly served notice on John Charles Salmons (hereinafter SALMONS) that it intended to issue a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000 for violation of ORS 701.055(1). The Notice further granted to SALMONS an opportunity for hearing, if requested within 21 days of service of the Notice. No such request has been received at the Board. The Notice designated the board's file on this matter as the record for purposes of default.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about July 6, 1996, SALMONS was not a registered contractor. SALMONS registration expired in May of 1994.
2. On or about July 6, 1996, SALMONS contracted with Esther and Richard Johnson to install rain gutters at their home located at 5426 Valley View Lane, Klamath Falls, Oregon. The job was not satisfactory, resulting in a complaint filed with the Board. SALMONS received \$937.50 for the work.

#### ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

SALMONS worked as a contractor while not registered with the Board on or about July 6, 1996.

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

SALMONS violated ORS 701.055(1) by working as a contractor while not registered with the Board.

#### ORDER

It is ordered that SALMONS pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.

If you have any questions about payment or wish to make payment arrangements, please call 378-4621. Make checks payable to the Construction Contractors Board.

**APPEAL RIGHTS:** You are entitled to judicial review of this order in accordance with ORS Chapter 183.480. You may request a judicial review by filing a petition with the Court of Appeals in Salem, Oregon, within 60 days from the date of this order. Tape recordings of Administrative Hearings are retained 90 days after the date of the final order. Duplicate tape recordings cost \$10 per tape.
