According to the provisions of ORS 368.341(3) and ORS 368.351, a petition containing the acknowledged signatures of the owners of 100% of the property abutting the public property described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, proposed to be vacated and condicating said owners' approval of the proposed vacation was filed with the Board of Commissioners on October 24, 1997.

Thereafter, the Public Works Director filed with the Commissioners a written report containing the required information of ORS 368.346(1), finding the vacation to be in the public interest.

Now, after fully considering the report and other documentation presented, the Board of County Commissioners find that the vacation of a portion of DeLap Pit Road (Jackson Avenue) in Klamath County, Oregon, as described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is in the public interest and finds that the petition should be granted and that the property vacated would benefit the public by being placed on the tax rolls. This Order stipulated that the vacation is subject to easements for existing public utilities to operate facilities in the vacated areas.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition is granted and that the portion described herein is vacated, as said vacation in the public interest. It is further ordered that pursuant to ORS 365.366(1)(d) the vacated property is vested in the owners of the abutting property by extension of their property boundaries.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs resulting from the approved vacation is determined to be in the sum of \$150.00 and that the persons liable for payment of the costs are the petitioners, who have paid the above mentioned sum on November 2, 1998.

SUBJECT: VACATION OF PORTION OF DELAP ROAD (See attached

map and description)

The Board of County Commissioners accepted the petition for vacation and referred it to the County Road Official by Order #99-050 on November 10, 1998. One hundred percent of the adjoining private property owners signed the petition requesting the vacation. Therefore, notice to the adjoining owners was not required.

According to the County Assessor's records, the owners of the property abutting the road are as follows:

Tax Lots 100, 300 and 1200 Perry L. & Paulette Z. Welker 7506 Steens Drive Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601

Tax Lot 1100 Albert & Janet Chancellor 18564 Henry Melvindale, MI 48122

The section of the road proposed to be vacated was closed and a locked gate was placed at the Highway 97 right-of-way by Commissioners Order #95-149 dated March 22, 1995. Closing the road has stopped the numerous acts of vandalism that were occurring.

The road right-of-way was acquired by deed. If you choose to proceed with the vacation the following two steps are necessary. First, vacate the road. Second, prepare deeds deeding the right-of-way to the adjoining owners.

Notice was provided to all utility companies in the area. There are no utilities operating facilities in the area to be vacated.

The portion of Delap Road proposed to be vacated is not needed to access other properties in the area. Returning the property to the tax rolls would benefit the public. I recommend the property described in the petition be vacated.
