PAUL S. COSGROVE, SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE OF DEFAULT AND ELECTION TO SELL: Reference is made to that certain trust deed made by Judith A. Preslar as grantor, to Amerititle as trustee, in favor of Associates Financial Services Company of Oregon, Inc., as beneficiary, dated May 15, 1997 recorded May 16, 1997 in the mortgage records of Klamath County, Oregon, in Book 24-97 at page 15182 as recorder's fee no. 37839, covering the following described real property situated in said county and state, to-wit:

Notice is further given that any person named in ORS 86.753 has the right, at any time prior to five days before the date last set for the sale, to have the foreclosure proceeding dismissed and the trust deed reinstated by payment to the beneficiary of the entire amount then due (other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred) and by curing any other default complained of herein that is capable of being cured by tendering the performance required under the obligation or trust deed, and in addition to paying the sums or tendering the performance necessary to cure the default, by paying all costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the obligation and trust deed, together with trustee's and attorney's fees not exceeding the amounts provided by ORS 86.753.

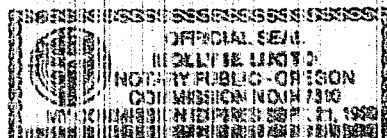
