1. NATURE OF THE REQUEST

The applicant has applied to establish a Kennel for 10 dogs on 40 acre zoned EFU-C. This request was heard by the hearings officer January 6, 1999. The request was reviewed for conformance with Klamath County Land Development Code.

3. LOCATION OF PROPERTY

The property in question is located at the SW corner of Crossroad and HWY 39 and is more particularly described as pr. NE 1/4 Sec. 12 T. 40N R. 9E, TA 4010-12-100.

4. MATERIALS CONSIDERED

All evidence submitted by the applicant and located in the Staff Report was considered as was the oral testimony given.

5. FINDINGS

The Hearings officer FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

- a. That this property is not high value farmland.
- b. That a kennel on this property will not disrupt the surrounding land uses.
- c. That the applicant may from time to time sell dogs or puppies from the site.

6. ORDER

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the applicant's request is approved subject to the following conditions:

- a. That the wastes from the Kennel are appropriately disposed of and result in no pollution to any waters.
- b. That the applicant files a restrictive covenant with the county clerk prohibiting the permit grantee and successors in interest from dividing this property or filing any complaint of any type or kind concerning the presently accepted resource management practices and farming uses that may occur on nearby lands devoted to commercial or other resource use.
- c. That the applicant complies fully with fire safety and other siting standards of the Land Use Code as set out in Article 69 of the LDC.
- d. That the applicant have no more than 20 dogs on the site without further permits.

- e. A site plan shall be reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission prior to construction.
- f. That all required building and placement permits or an extension of time be obtained within two (2) years following the date of this order or this approval will be void.
