BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seized of the estate hereby conveved and has the right to grunt and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and denands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

- 2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Subject to applicable law or to a written waiver by I ender Borrower shall pay to Lender on the day monthly payments are due under the Note, until the Note is paid in full, a sum ("Funds" for (a) yearly taxes and assessments which may attain priority over this Security Instrument as a lieu on the Property. (b) yearly leasehold payments or ground rents on the Property, if any. (c) yearly hazard or property insurance premiums, (d) yearly flood insurance premiums, if any. (e) yearly mortgagn insurance premiums if any and (t) any sums payable by Borrower to Lender, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 8 in lieu of the paymen, of mortgage insurance premiums. These items are called "Escrow Items" Lender may, at any time, collect and hold Funds in an amount not to exceed the maximum, amount a lender for a federally related mortgage loan may require for Borrower's escrow account under the federal Real Estate Settlement Procedures Act of 1974 as amended from time to time, 12 U.S.C. Sec. 2601 et seq. ("EESPA"), unless another law that applies to the Punds sets a lesser amount. If so, Lender may, at any time, collect and nold Funds in an amount not to exceed the lesser amount. - 1. Application of Payments. - 4. Charges: Liens. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

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Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the armount of the payments. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within sixty days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless I ender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's centro'. Borrower shall not desiroy, damage or impair the Property allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any torfe-ture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Betrower may cure such a default and reinstate, as provided in paragraph 18, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a ruling that, in Lender's good faith determination, procludes forfeiture of the Borrower's interest in the Property or other material impairment of the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall also be in default if Borrower during the loan application process, gave materially false or maccurate information or statements to Lender for failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Nete including, but not limited to, representations concerning Borrewer's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold. Borrower shall comply with all the provisions of the lease. - 7 Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect I ender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture or to enforce laws or regulations), then I ender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys fees and entering on the Property to make repairs. In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. - 12. Successors and Assigns Bound: Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note. (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the arms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument, and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.
- 13. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to

15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provision of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security instrument and the Note are declared to bis everable.

16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security

Instrument 17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any micrest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lendor's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument

18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. If Borrower meets certain conditions. Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of (a) 5 days for such other period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note as if no acceleration had occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements. (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable atturney's fees, and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, dam, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party havelving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other temediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary. As used in this paragraph 20, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and laws of the jurisdiction where the Property is located that relate to health, safety or environmental projection

NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows.

21. Acceleration; Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrower prior to acceleration following Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument (but not prior to acceleration under paragraph 17 unless applicable law provides otherwise). The notice shall specify (a) the default, (b) the action required to cure the default, (c) a date, not less than 36 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument and sale of the Property. If one or more riders are executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Security Instrument, the covenants and agreements of each such oder shall be incorporated into and shall amend and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument as if the index(s) were a part of this Security Instrument.
