WHEREAS,

CHARLES BARKIN

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Lewiston, Oregon, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Charles Barkin

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 26th of April, 1860, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the Lots one and two and the south half of the northeast quarter of Section four in Township thirty-eight south of Range eleven west of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing one hundred thirty-one and eighty-five hundredths acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Charles Barkin:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Charles Barkin

and to his heirs, the said tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Charles Barkin

and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I, Woodrow Wilson, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

DECLARATION OF LAND PATENT

United States Land Patent No. 4782, issued on the 13th day of September, 1907, by Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America.

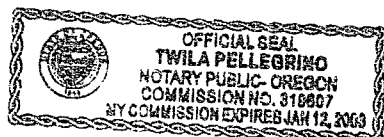
